- Applicant must be enrolled in a university, college, or trade school program for Fall of 2020.
- Application must be completed and signed by the applicant and parent/legal guardian (See last page).
- **Completed application packet must be submitted in its entirety. Packet includes the following:**
 - Completed and signed application
 - Application must be printed legibly or typed
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation
 - School Official/Teacher
 - Friend/Mentor member
 - An official transcript
 - Acceptance letter must be submitted prior to funds being disbursed to the scholarship recipient's institution
 - Essay Question must be typed with a 500-word maximum
 - Dealing with Adversity: Describe the most significant challenge you have faced and the steps you have taken to address this challenge. Include whether you turned to anyone when facing the challenge, the role the person played, and what you learned about yourself and how has this prepared you for college.

- b. Each applicant must complete a 500 word maximum Essay on the following: “Describe how receiving this scholarship will help you to reach your goals.”

Kappa Alpha Psi Scholarship Only - All scholarship applicants must answer the following:

- a. One paragraph on knowledge of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. (250 words or less typed)
- b. Describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability both in and out of school. (Between 300 - 500 words typed).

Please attach the essays to your completed application.

All Kappa Alpha Psi Scholarship applicants should have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale to be considered for scholarship funds.

Alpha Kappa Alpha

- a. Applicants must have a 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- b. In a 500 word maximum essay explain the importance of female leadership and how Alpha Kappa Alpha has given the world wonderful examples to emulate.
- c. Please submit a typed copy of your essay for review.
